

1. \_\_\_\_\_ (v35) And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

2. \_\_\_\_\_ (v41-42) The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, I am the bread which came down from heaven. <sup>42</sup> And they said, Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? how is it then that he saith, I came down from heaven?

3. \_\_\_\_\_ (v51) I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live forever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

4. \_\_\_\_\_ (v52) The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can this man give us his flesh to eat?

5. \_\_\_\_\_ (v58) This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna and are dead: he that eats of this bread shall live forever.

6. \_\_\_\_\_ (v60) Many therefore of his disciples, when they had heard this, said, This is an hard saying; who can hear it?

7. \_\_\_\_\_ (v66) From that time many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him.

8. \_\_\_\_\_ (v67) Then said Jesus unto the twelve, Will ye also go away?

9. \_\_\_\_\_ (v68-69) Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life. <sup>69</sup> And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.

10. \_\_\_\_\_ (v70) Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
