

"1 Peter-The Hard Things in Scripture" Chapter 3:1-4:6 September 17, 2025

1. _____ (3:1) *Likewise* you wives, in the same way submit yourselves to your own husbands so that, if any of them do not believe the word, they may be won over without words by the behavior of their wives.
2. _____ (3:2) *Likewise*, you husbands, in the same way be considerate with your wives and treat them with respect as the weaker partner and as heirs of the gracious gift of life, so that nothing will hinder your prayers.
3. _____ (3:8-9) Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous: ⁹ Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but on the contrary a blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing.
4. _____ (3:12) The eyes of the Lord are over the righteous-His ears open to their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil.
5. _____ (3:14-15a) But and if ye suffer for righteousness' sake, happy are ye: and be not afraid of their terror, neither be troubled ¹⁵ But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts.
6. _____ (3:15b) Be ready always to give an answer to every man that ask you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear.
7. _____ (3:16-17) Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be ashamed that falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ. For it is better, if the will of God be so, that ye suffer for well doing, than for evil doing.
8. _____ (3:18-19) For Christ once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit: ¹⁹ By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison.
9. _____ (3:20-21) Which sometime were disobedient-God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water. ²¹ The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
10. _____ (4:4-6) Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you: ⁵ Who shall give account to him that is ready to judge the quick and the dead. ⁶ For this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit.
