

1. _____ "They said, The remnants of the captivity are in great affliction and reproach: the wall of Jerusalem is broken down, and the gates are burned with fire." (1:3)
2. _____ "I pray before You now, day and night, and confess the sins of the children of Israel, which we have sinned against You: both I and my father's house have sinned." (1:6)
3. _____ "I told them of the hand of God which was good upon me; as also the king's words. They said, Let us rise up and build-so they strengthened their hands for this good work." (2:18)
4. _____ "When Sanballat, Tobiah and Geshem heard it, they laughed at us and despised us, and said, what is this thing that you do?" (2:19)
5. _____ "So built we the wall; and all the wall was joined together unto the half thereof: for the people had a mind to work." (4:6)
6. _____ "Sanballat and Tobiah-the Arabians-and others heard that the walls of Jerusalem were made up, and that the breaches were being stopped-they were very wroth-and conspired together to come and to fight against Jerusalem, and to hinder it." (4:7-8)
7. _____ "There was a great cry of the people against their brethren the Jews- some had mortgaged their lands-that they might buy corn, others borrowed money for the king's tribute. Nehemiah was very angry because the Jews were exacting usury, every one of his brother." (5:1-7)
8. _____ "Sanballat and Geshem said, Come, let us meet together in a village in the plain of Ono. They thought to do me mischief. I sent a message, saying, I am doing a great work-I cannot come down: why should the work cease while I leave it, and come down to you? (6:1-3)
9. _____ "They sent to me four times after this sort; and I answered them after the same manner. Then sent Sanballat his servant unto me in like manner the fifth time with an open letter in his hand" (6:4-5)
10. _____ "The wall was finished in the twenty and fifth day of the month Elul, in fifty and two days. When all our enemies heard thereof, and the heathen saw these things, they were much cast down in their own eyes: for they perceived that this work was wrought of our God." (6:15-16)
