

“Abram and Lot” Genesis 13 August 30, 2026

- 1.(v1-2) _____ Abram went up out of Egypt, his wife, all that he had, and Lot with him, to the south. Abram was very rich-cattle, silver, gold.
- 2.(v3-4) _____ He went on his journeys from south to Bethel, to the place-at the beginning, between Bethel and Hai; to the place of the altar, which he had made first: and there Abram called on the name of the LORD.
- 3.(v5-7) _____ Lot also, which went with Abram, had flocks, herds, and tents. The land was not able to bear them, that they might dwell together: for their substance was great, so that they could not dwell together. There was strife between the herdsmen of Abram's cattle and the herdsmen of Lot's cattle: The Canaanite and Perizzite dwelled then in the land.
- 4.(v8-9) _____ Abram said to Lot, Let there be no strife between me and you- my herdsmen and your herdsmen-we be brethren. ⁹ Is not the whole land before you? Separate yourself from me: if you will take the left hand-I will go to the right; or if you depart to the right hand- I will go to the left.
- 5.(v10-11) _____ Lot lifted up his eyes and saw all the plain of Jordan-it was well watered everywhere, before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah, even as the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt, as you come unto Zoar. Then Lot chose him all the plain of Jordan; and Lot journeyed east: and they separated themselves the one from the other.
- 6.(v12) _____ Abram dwelled in the land of Canaan, and Lot dwelled in the cities of the plain, and pitched his tent toward Sodom.
- 7.(v13) _____ The men of Sodom were wicked and sinners before the Lord exceedingly
- 8.(v14-15) _____ And the LORD said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him, Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward; For all the land which you sees to you will I give it, and to your seed forever.
- 9.(v16) _____ And I will make your seed as the dust of the earth-if a man can number the dust of the earth-your seed also be numbered.
- 10.(v17-18) _____ Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it to you. Then Abram removed his tent and came and dwelt in the plain of Mamre (strength), which is in Hebron (unity) , and built there an altar unto the LORD (3RD ALTAR).
