M25 is a ministry-based Matthew 25. It was started to support Hepsibah Association in Romania and in the Kotiang Baptist Church in Kenya Africa

HEPSIBAH ASSOCIATION IN CEHU ROMANIA

Hepsibah Association was founded in 2012, with a heart to reach children from a local orphanage. Manuela Pop began serving with the ministry in 2014 alongside her husband, Andrei. In 2016, Andrei tragically passed away in a car accident.

Just two months later, their daughter, Abi, was born.

In 2020–2021, a mission house was built. It has become a home for ministry, fellowship and discipleship. Today, the ministry continues to reach children and young people in many beautiful ways:

- *Ministry with orphan children. Some of the children are now grown and have given their lives to the Lord and are actively serving by leading children's activities. Andrei and Adriana are a testimony of God's transforming grace.
- * English classes for children in town. * Music lessons in ukulele and guitar.
- * Christmas and Easter concerts that bring families together.
- * Saturday Bible studies with children from town.
- * English classes in local kindergartens. * Six weeks of VBS each summer.
- * An Internship Program that disciples and trains teenagers to serve children.
- * The Romanian Christmas Shoe Box Ministry to over 350 children.

KOTIANG BAPTIST CHURCH IN KENYA

Started as a home Bible study, the church was established in 2013 as the only Biblically based church in the village. To date there have been 116 Baptisms and 155 average Sunday attendance. Their many ministries include:

- *2026 Education Assistance 48 students in High School, College, and Universities
- *Farming Assistance Providing seeds, fertilizer and oxen for plowing
- *Men's Ministry provides hands on support in the village
- *Women's Ministry supports widows and teaches young girls
- *VBS and Community Outreach help those in need

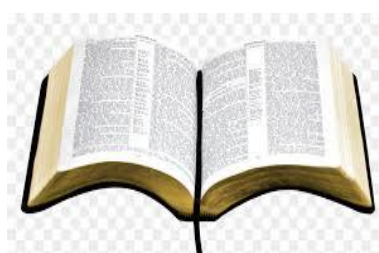
