



The letter-“Zayin”-the 7th letter with the numeric value of 7. The definition-“crown” or “to sustain” or “war or weapons”. The top of Zayin is a handle, and the vertical leg is the blade. Seven is the most prominent number in the Hebrew language: “Good”, Pairs of animals-ark, Noah waiting, colors in rainbow, furniture in Tabernacle, battle of Jericho, Lord’s Prayer, Words from the cross, the little boy’s lunch, churches, seals, trumpets, bowls, tribulation in Revelation-most important THE SABBATH of days, of years, of decades, of millenniums

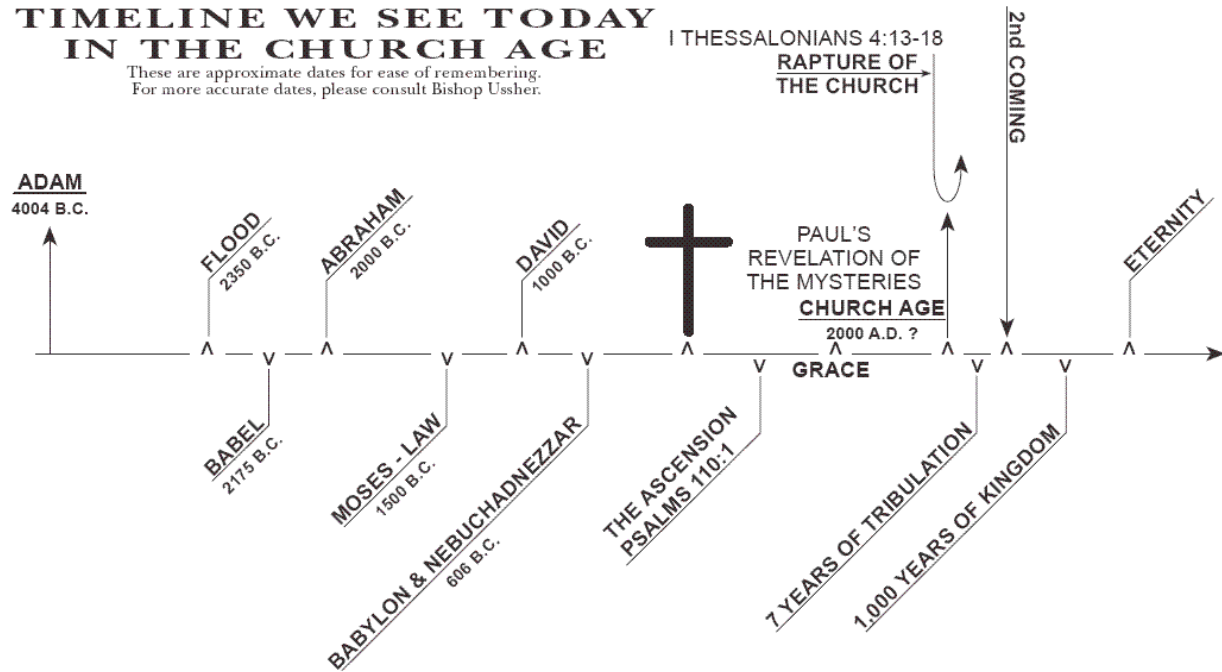
