1. \_\_\_\_\_(v31-32) The Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan has desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: <sup>32</sup> But I have prayed for you, that your faith fail not: and when you are converted, strengthen your brethren.

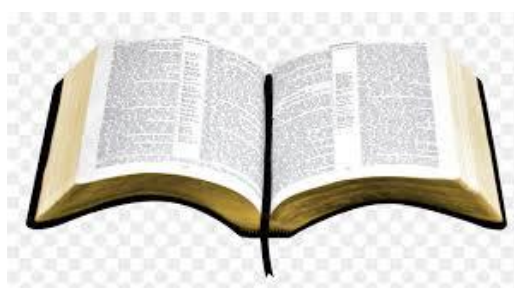
